



**Entry into this Contest constitutes your acceptance of these Official Rules.**

**Instructions:** Please initial EACH page of this document. You will also need to complete the OAUG Emcee Idol entry form in its entirety. Both signed/initial forms **MUST** be submitted **ALONG** with your 2-3 minute video. Forms will **NOT** be reviewed without a video and videos will **NOT** be reviewed without **BOTH** forms completed, signed/initialed.

**CONTEST ENTRY DATES:** Contest begins February 20, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. Eastern Time and ends March 21, 2008 at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time ("Contest Entry Period"). Entries will be accepted during the Contest Entry Period and voted on the week of March 24, 2008.

**WHO MAY ENTER:** Open to all current OAUG members in good standing age 21 and older. OAUG committee members, Board of Directors, staff, council members (and their immediate families (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside or those living in the same households, whether or not related) are not eligible to enter or win.

The OAUG Meeting of the Members is currently scheduled on Wednesday, April 16, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. The winning Idol must be available on Tuesday, April 15, 2008 at 4:45 p.m. for a one-hour dress rehearsal, as well as available Wednesday, April 16, 2008 from 12:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.

**CONTEST ENTRY/OBJECTIVE:** The object of the Contest is for you, the OAUG member, to submit a 2-3 minute video demonstrating and showcasing your creativity and ability to emcee a show/meeting. The ideal emcee will be humorous, charismatic, well spoken, have ability to energize and engage the OAUG audience, be able to memorize scripted talking points and have an understanding of Oracle Applications. Key points to mention in your video are: your name, company, how long you've been an OAUG member and what brings you to the COLLABORATE 08 conference.

\*All videos sent via postal mail MUST be received by March 21, 2008. Any videos received after this date will be disqualified. Having your video post marked on March 21, 2008 does not constitute a valid entry. Entry must be in our hands by March 21, 2008. Videos submitted via postal mail will not be returned to the Contestant.

The OAUG Meeting of the Members is currently scheduled on Wednesday, April 16, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. The winning Idol must be available on Tuesday, April 15, 2008 for a one-hour dress rehearsal, as well as available Wednesday, April 16, 2008 from 12:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Videos should be submitted in .mpg (MPEG), .avi (AVI), .wmv (Windows Media), or .mov (QuickTime) format and smaller than 100MB. Videos submitted via postal mail may also be in standard NTSC DVD-Video or VHS cassette format. The winner will be notified on or around April 1, 2008 and announced at the OAUG Meeting of the Members hosted at COLLABORATE on Wednesday, April 16, 2008 in Denver, Colorado. Videos submitted via postal mail will not be returned to the Contestant.

Only one entry per member can be submitted. Incomplete Entries, including but not limited to: those Entries that do not have a completed entry form (and signature) and a non-address of the requirements listed in the Contest Entry/Objective section, will not be eligible for the judging. All Entries must be received by March 21, 2008 at 11:59 p.m. ET.

By submitting an Entry, contestant hereby grants the OAUG permission for his/her Entry to be posted on oaug.org for viewing by visitors to the Web site and otherwise used in accordance with these Official Rules. In addition to a contestant's video, the OAUG reserves the right to post sample videos on YouTube.com and showcase clips during the Meeting of the Members during COLLABORATE 08 and other similar OAUG functions. The OAUG reserves the right to modify/alter/delete any submissions.

Entry must be the original work of the contestant, may not have been previously published, may not have won previous awards, and must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity. If the Entry contains any material or elements that are not owned by the contestant and/or which are subject to the rights of third parties, the contestant is responsible for obtaining, prior to submission of the Entry, any and all releases and consents necessary to permit the use and exhibition of the Entry by the OAUG in the manner set forth in these Official Rules, including, without limitation, name and likeness permissions from any person who appears in or is identifiable in the Entry. If any identifiable person appearing in the Entry is under the age of 21, the parent or legal guardian is required to provide written authorization for the minor to appear in the Entry. The OAUG reserves the right to request proof of these permissions in a form acceptable to the OAUG from any contestant at any time. By submitting an Entry, contestant warrants and represents that he/she and any persons appearing or who are identifiable in the Entry consents to the submission and use of the Entry in the Contest, and to its posting on oaug.org.

Entries must comply with the following content guidelines to be eligible:

- Content cannot be sexually explicit or suggestive, unnecessarily violent or derogatory of any ethnic, racial, gender, religious, professional or age group, profane or pornographic, or contain nudity;
- Content cannot promote alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons (or the use of any of the foregoing), any activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous, or any particular political agenda or message;
- Content cannot be obscene or offensive, endorse any form of hate or hate group;
- Content cannot defame, misrepresent or contain disparaging remarks about the OAUG, other people, products or companies;

- Content cannot contain copyrighted materials owned by others (including photographs, sculptures, paintings and other works of art or images published on or in websites, television, movies or other media) without permission;
- Content cannot contain materials embodying the names, likenesses, photographs, or other indicia identifying any person, living or dead, without permission;
- Content cannot communicate messages or images inconsistent with the positive images and/or goodwill to which Sponsor wishes to associate; and
- Content cannot depict and cannot itself be in violation of any law or otherwise.

The OAUG reserves the right to disqualify any Entry for any reason, in its sole and absolute discretion.

**WINNER NOTIFICATION:** Potential Winner will be determined on or about April 1, 2008. Potential Winner will be notified via e-mail and/or telephone on or about April 1, 2008 and will be required to execute and return an Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability and, unless prohibited by law, Publicity Release ("Affidavit/Release") as well as any other documents which may be required by the OAUG, all of which must be received fully-executed within two (2) days of the date printed on the notification or the Winner may be disqualified.

In the event it is determined that Winner has not complied with these Official Rules, or has failed to execute and return any required documents within the specified time period, has made false statements or a prize notification is returned as undeliverable, then the Winner will be disqualified. Should the Winner make any false statement(s) in any document required by the OAUG, the Winner will be disqualified and required to promptly return to Sponsor his/her prize. If the Winner is disqualified for any reason, at the OAUG's discretion, the Entry with the next highest score may be declared the alternate Winner.

In the event that OAUG doesn't receive any acceptable winning auditions, OAUG reserves the right to cancel the contest at any point.

Note: there is no cash value for the complimentary hotel room - a credit card is required for any/all incidentals. The complimentary conference registration and hotel room is non-transferable.

Released Parties are also not responsible for problems uploading or downloading any Contest-related information or materials from the web site or for any other technical malfunctions of electronic equipment, computer on-line systems, servers, or providers, computer hardware or software failures, phone lines, failure of any Entry to be received by the OAUG on account of technical problems, traffic, congestion on the internet or the Web site, or for any other technical problems including telecommunication, miscommunication or failure, and failed, lost, delayed, incomplete, garbled or misdirected communications which may limit a contestant's ability to participate in the Contest. Released Parties are not responsible for any other errors or malfunctions of any kind, whether network, printing, typographical, human or otherwise relating to or in connection with the Contest, including, without limitation, errors or malfunctions which may occur in connection with the administration of the Contest, the processing or judging of Entries, the tabulating of ratings, the announcement of prize or in any Contest-related materials. Mass Entries or Entries generated by a script, macro or use of automated devices will be disqualified. The OAUG reserves the right to modify, suspend or

terminate the Contest in the event it becomes infected by a computer virus or is otherwise technically impaired, and to cancel or suspend the Contest in its entirety should tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or other causes corrupt the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper play of the Contest and, if terminated, at the OAUG's discretion, determine the top-rated Entries and/or winner (as applicable) using all non-suspect, eligible Entries received up to time of cancellation using the judging procedure outlined above. In the event of a dispute regarding Entries received from multiple users having the same e-mail account, the authorized subscriber of the e-mail account at the time of Entry will be deemed to be the contestant and must comply with these Official Rules. Authorized subscriber is the natural person who is assigned the e-mail address by the Internet Service Provider (ISP), on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses. The OAUG reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the Entry process or the operation of the Contest or Web site, intending to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other contestant, the OAUG or any of its representatives or to otherwise be acting in violation of these Official Rules and void all associated Entries.

**CAUTION:** Any attempt by a contestant to deliberately damage any Web site or undermine the legitimate operations of the Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, the OAUG reserves the right to seek damages from any such contestant to the fullest extent permitted by law and to disqualify such contestant from the Contest.

The OAUG reserves the right to permanently disqualify any person it believes has intentionally violated these Official Rules. Contest subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited by law. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
